Dear Mr. Hach:

It's my pleasure to write this letter on behalf of my Board of Directors and its members to express our support for the H.Res.596 proposed bill that was introduced in the House of Representative on May 22nd, 2014 to be passed by both branches of the U.S Congress in order to reach to the Desk of U.S President for his signature into law.

During the Vietnam War, Cambodian National Armed Forces joined with U.S Armed Forces to fight and to defend freedom and democracy and also to support U.S operations in Cambodia and Laos against North Vietnamese and Vietcong forces and its allied communist blocs. During that time, one of our active members, an Air Force helicopter pilot, rescued an F111 US Pilot that was shot down in 1973 in enemy controlled territory and returned him to safety.

Furthermore, many of our Cambodian Armed Forces personnel, who survived the Khmer Rouge Killing Field, currently live in The United States. They were soldiers, non-commissioned officers and officers that were trained by U.S instructors.

Finally we look forward to work with your organization to pursue the passage of this bill to the finish line and to the Desk of US President.
